Lieselotte Kimmel Schattall, 98, passed away on the morning of May 25, 2021. She was born October 14, 1922 in Frankfurt, Germany. Her parents, Adam and Margarete Kimmel, immigrated to the United States in August of 1923 when she was 10 months old. The family settled in East Baltimore, MD, where she grew up, and she traveled several times back to Germany with her parents to visit their many relatives. Later, in 1940, she graduated from Eastern High School in Baltimore with a concentration in business courses, and she got her first job as a secretary at Monumental Life Insurance Company on North Charles Street. She met her lifelong sweetheart, Julius Schattall, while out with her friends at the Deutsches House, a German restaurant in Baltimore City, and they married in October of 1945. After her husband was Honorably Discharged from the Army Air Corp in Wendover, Utah, they returned to Maryland and eventually settled in Pikesville to raise their family. After retirement, they traveled extensively in Europe and enjoyed adventuring across the United States in their RV. During her retirement, she loved to paint and passed on many of her works to her family and friends. She loved to play the piano, the accordion, and she was a talented seamstress. Her sewing machine always traveled with them in the RV. She was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother and was very involved in her Catholic Church.

She was preceded in death by her youngest son, Christopher, who was a victim of cancer at 10 years old in 1968. Also her husband, Julius, of 75 years, recently passed in January of 2021 from illness due to Covid-19 at the age of 99.

She is survived by her son, Frederick J. Schattall and his wife, Cheryl of Bluffton, SC, and her daughter Stephanie M. Rohe and her husband, Ed of Bethany Beach, DE.

She was blessed with 7 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren and 1 great-great granddaughter.
